- ✚ To provide an idea about how to design and develop Institutional Repository (IR) and digital library using (Dspace) Open Source Software.
- ✚ To create, designing and develop IR and digital using DSpace with hands –on- training.

Train: Kalka is a small railway station that connects trains to Shimla.

Bus: Shimla is connected to major cities in North India by several bus services including Himachal Road Transport Corporation buses as well as private operators.

Air: Shimla can be easily reached by air. The place has its own airport at a place called Jubbarhatti, which is located at a distance of 23 kilometres from the main city centre.
